Request for Information Regarding Aircraft Route Data

Dear Nav Canada,

I am writing to you as the director of a Canadian human rights organisation working on transparency issues, the Centre for Law and Democracy, with the support of transparency organisation Access Info Europe and the legal action charity Reprieve. I submitted an Access to Information Act request for certain flight information (see below) to the Canadian Air Transport Security Authority (CATSA), and they indicated to me that you hold relevant information.

In a telephone conversation on 17 October, one of your legal staff confirmed that you hold the information but indicated that, as a private company, you would normally provide this information to the government only in the context of a safety or police investigation.

I understand your standard position on this issue. However, I believe that there are strong public interest arguments in favour of making this information public, and few countervailing arguments in favour of secrecy. The flight data in question relates to flights we believe were commissioned by the Government of the United States of America, and which are suspected of being related to a global programme involving extradition and torture. International standards on transparency indicate clearly that information relating to the abuse of human rights should always be made public.

I note that similar information has already been made public in other countries, for example, in Finland (see:

http://www.formin.fi/Public/default.aspx?contentid=233396&nodeid=15145&culture=fi-FI). Making this information available to civil society will enable us to analyse whether these flights are likely to have been part of the illegal programme or not.

I am therefore hereby writing to request information and documents held by you or stored in archives accessible to you regarding aircraft route data. Specifically, I am requesting the following:

For each plane listed below, please provide information and documents relating to that plane's passage through Canadian airspace, its origin, its destination and any landings at Canadian airports, between the specified dates.
