An electronic search of the Federal Aviation Administration's Enhanced Traffic Management System (ETMS) database was performed and the available records are contained within the enclosed Microsoft[®] Excel file. Those flights for which we do not have any records are noted in the enclosed file. Please note that the ETMS database only has records for flights, which operated under instrument flight rules or were handled by air traffic control in a radar environment. The records are sorted by the departure date and time. All dates and times are in Greenwich mean time.

The undersigned is responsible for the partial no records determination. Should you consider this partial no records response a denial of your request, you may request reconsideration of this determination by writing to the Assistant Administrator for Finance and Management (AFN-1), Federal Aviation Administration, 800 Independence Avenue, SW, Washington DC, 20591. Your request must be made in writing within 30 days from the date of receipt of this letter and must include all information and arguments relied upon. Your letter must also state that it is an appeal from the above-described denial of a request made under the FOIA. The envelope containing the appeal should be marked "FOIA."
