Global network

Since 2015, more than **74 governments and 53 organisations** have joined the ODC network.

In a partnership model with local, regional, and global initiatives, such as the Open Government Partnership (OGP), the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), and the Open Data for Development Network (OD4D), the ODC is increasingly shaping data policies around the world.

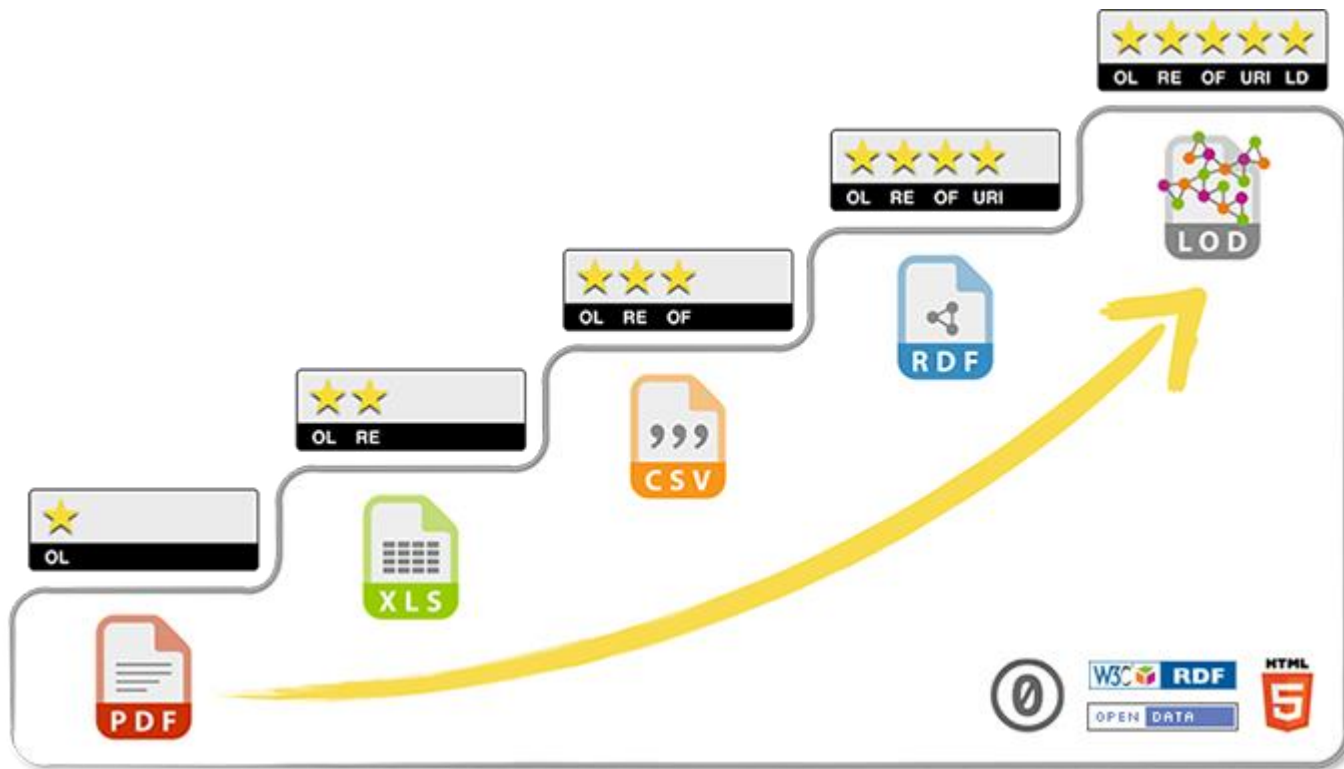

- *Open data — making data free, publicly available, and machine-readable for anyone to access and use, without restrictions — is a key operating principle for producing data for use and impact. It facilitates greater information-sharing within government and provides public insight into a country's progress in a way that allows a variety of stakeholders to contribute data, expertise, and resources. ***SDGrepoting.org***

Background

In 2018, the Statistical Commission, in its [decision 49/105](#), created a subgroup on open data under the Friends of the Chair group on the Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics (FOC-FPOS) to work on principles, guidance and support for the implementation of open data in countries. The subgroup presented its work at the 50th session of the Commission including a mapping of open data principles to the Fundamental Principles, a synthesis of existing open data work and analysis of other matters relating to the implementation of open data in official statistics.

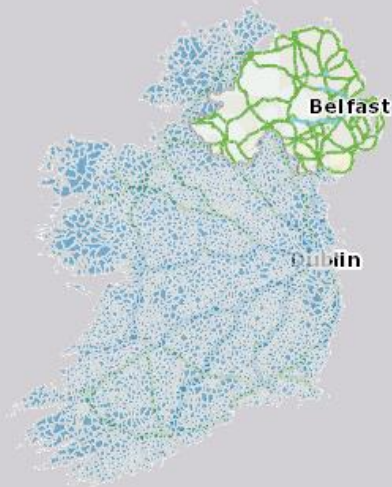
