

Dear Ms. Medland,

Regarding your request for information dated 18 November 2011, please, find below our answer:

AFTN

According to ICAO Annex 10, Volume II, para 4.4.1.6 (Long - term retention of AFTN traffic records) "Copies of all messages, in their entirety transmitted by an AFTN origin station shall be retained for a period of at least 30 days."

CRCO

According to EUROCONTROL CRCO (Central Route Charges Office) Document 716028, 18th Ed. / 1 July 2011, para 2.3.5. the following regulation for National administrations applies:

2.3.5. How long to preserve the flight plans?

All flight plans used for the collection of data for transmission, as well as reference data used to justify decisions made in validating any flight or series of flights, must be preserved by the National Administrations for at least four years from the date of flight.

In case it is not yet possible for a particular RCO to meet this requirement, flight data must be kept for a minimum of 18 months after the date of flight.

Since your request refers to the flights which may took place not earlier but 5 years ago, Slovenia Control regrets the fact that requested information are not available any more.
